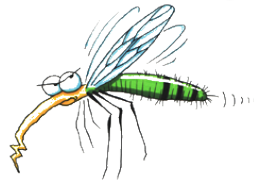




KATO'S TIPS FOR MOSQUITO CONTROL



There is not just 1 thing but an overlapping defense we can use against Mosquitos.

1. Cover all bare areas of soil with mulch. Shredded cedar repels mosquitos and other insects.
2. Spread cedar coated granules, monthly, April-October. Cedarcide or Yardsafe can be purchased at organic garden centers like Rhodes, North Haven or Plants & Planters.
3. Shake mosquito bits twice per month in bird baths, downspouts, drains and wet areas in your landscape. This is the same ingredient that is in mosquito dunks for ponds and rain barrels.
4. Spray organic mosquito control weekly. Cedar, citronella or other natural repellents kill on contact plus make a barrier. Excellent to spray additionally, for a gathering or yard party.
